Become a Leader

Position	Description
Group Leader Mt Clear - looking for 2024 start.	<p>Group Leaders are our local group managers. They support the Group's Section Leaders who are at the forefront of delivering the youth program. Also, Group Leaders manage the Group's Support committees to support the Group's youth program and resources. Interpersonal skills are important in this role they need to work with Leaders, Partners, Committee and community groups in supporting our section leaders who run the programs.</p> <p>This position reports to the District Commission for Ballarat.</p> <p>Estimated time is 2-3 hours per week</p>
Assistant Joey Leader	<p>Working closely to support the experienced Joey leader, at the 5-7 year age the leader creates the program with ideas from the joeys on what they want to do. They also encourage the joeys to run things like games or small activities as part of them learning to lead.</p> <p>Scouts Victoria provides training in how to be an assistant joey leader, you will also have support from our experienced leaders in the group, the district and regional Joey leaders.</p>
Assistant Scout Leader	<p>Assistant Scout Leaders support the running of our program for the Scout section. 11yr – 15yr. They work with the scouts to create a weekly program that is fun, engaging and helps the scouts grow. At this age the leaders works with the older scouts to create the program that considers the desires of all the scouts. They also encourage the younger Scouts to run some and for the older scouts they support them in running night programs or outside of hall activities to teach all levels leadership.</p> <p>Scouts Victoria provides training in how to be a Scout leader, you will have the support from the two experienced Scout leaders, as well as the district and regional Scout leaders.</p>

Venturer Leader

Venturer Leaders run our program for the [Venturer section](#). 15yr – 18yr. They support the Venturers to create a weekly program that is fun, engaging and helps the Venturers prepare to become young adults. At this age the leader supports the venturers in learning to run a unit council where a voted sub group of the venturers create the weekly program that considers the desires of all the Venturers. The unit council also manages its funds and correspondence. Depending on the experience of the venturers you might need to lead the council or just mentor it. On the Venturer nights your role to is to encourage and support them in running their program.
